**ARTIST ELIGIBILITY:** All members are invited to participate. Nonmembers may participate by becoming a member. (Membership: \$30 for adults and \$40 for families. Membership year runs from September 1 through August 31. Membership Form—last page of this document.)

**PRIZES AND AWARDS** given during the Opening Reception (except People’s Choice):

NOTE: Each award category must be represented by five or more artists in order to be awarded. Independent judge to be determined.

- \$75 Technical Expertise Award
- \$75 Level of Creativity Award

**MEDIUMS:** Open to all two- and three-dimensional media.

## ART SPECIFICATIONS:

- All entries must be **original work, not AI assisted, done in the past five years, and not previously exhibited** at a PAS Spring Show or the Small Works & Holiday Marketplace.
- Up to **three entries** per artist.
- All pieces must have a **label** (see entry form) attached to the back/bottom.
- The show coordinators will make every effort to accommodate all entries but reserve the right to refuse entries on the basis of available display space, installation needs, or suitability.

### Two-dimensional work:

- Limited to **36" maximum** in largest outside dimension including frame. Multiple large pieces may limit the number of entries allowed. Pieces larger than 36" may be accepted on a case-by-case basis and will limit the number of your entries. Diptychs or Triptychs are treated as 2 or 3 separate entries if not attached to one another. If the pieces are well attached/connected, can be reasonably hung as a single unit, and size is limited to 36" maximum, we will do our best to accept it.
- All work must be **firmly wired across the back and presentation ready for hanging on the wall**. No sawtooth hangers or clip frames.

### Three-dimensional work:

- Cannot require special installation. For questions about your display, contact us for guidance at [contact@princetonarts.org](mailto:contact@princetonarts.org).
- If submitting large pieces, may be limited by available space to one large item.

## HANGING /PLACEMENT FEE:

\$5 fee required for each piece, collected at drop-off. Cash or check. (No credit cards)

**ENTRY PROCEDURE:** Artwork, Entry Form, and Fee due at drop-off. No preregistration.
