DATES:

- OPENING RECEPTION and AWARDS: Friday, May 3, 6 - 8 p.m.
- GALLERY: Saturday and Sunday, May 4 & 5, 10 a.m. - 4 p.m.

ARTIST ELIGIBILITY: All members are invited to participate. Nonmembers may participate by becoming a member. (Membership: \$30 for adults and \$40 for families. Membership year runs from September 1 through August 31.)

PRIZES AND AWARDS given during the Opening Reception:

NOTE: Each award category must be represented by five or more artists in order to be given out.

- \$100 Steve Breen Best in Show
- \$75 in each of the following categories: 1) Technical Expertise, 2) Level of Creativity, and 3) Visual Impact
- \$75 Washburn Watercolor Award
- \$75 Jean Murphy Portrait Award – no photography
- \$75 3-Dimensional Award
- \$25 Honorable Mention (3+)
- \$25 People's Choice Award (given at end of show)

MEDIUMS: Open to all two- and three-dimensional media.

ART SPECIFICATIONS:

- **Original work, done in the past five years, not previously exhibited** at any PAS Show.
- Up to **three entries** per artist.
- Two-dimensional art:
 - Limited to **36" maximum** in largest outside dimension including frame. Larger pieces may be accepted on a case-by-case basis. Can be framed or not framed if appropriately presented.
 - Must be **firmly wired, and presentation ready**. No sawtooth hangers or clip frames.
- Three-dimensional work:
 - Cannot require special installation. Questions about appropriate submissions, contact us for guidance at contact@princetonarts.org.
 - If submitting large pieces, may be limited by available space to one large item.
- All pieces must have a **label** (see entry form) attached to the back/bottom.
- The show coordinators will make every effort to accommodate all entries but reserve the right to refuse entries on the basis of available display space, installation requirements, or suitability.

HANGING /PLACEMENT FEE:

\$5 fee required for each piece, collected at drop-off. Cash or check.

ENTRY PROCEEDURE: Artwork, Entry Form and Fee due at drop-off.

Entry Form includes price or NFS. Advanced registration NOT required.
